

A1.1.2 Les pronoms personnels : "je, tu, il/elle/on, nous, vous, ils/elles"



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The personal pronouns are: "je, tu, il/elle/on, nous, vous, ils/elles"

1. Pronouns reflect the gender (masculine or feminine) and the number (singular or plural) of the subject.
2. "Tu" is used in an informal situation.
3. "Vous" is used to speak to several people or in a formal situation to show respect to one person (politeness).

Singulier (Singular)	Pluriel (Plural)	Exemples (Examples)
Je (I)	Nous (We)	Je suis Monsieur Martin (I am Mr Martin) Nous sommes italiens (We are Italian)
Tu (You (informal, singular))	Vous (You (formal singular / plural))	Salut François, tu vas bien ? (Hi François, are you doing well?) Bonjour Monsieur, comment allez- vous ? (Hello Sir, how are you?) Vous jouez tous les trois. (You three are playing.)
Il / Elle / On (He / She / One (we/people))	Ils / Elles (They (masc./mixed) / They (fem.))	Comment s'appelle-t- elle ? (What is her name?) On est français (We are French) Ils sont avec Monsieur et Madame Dubois. (They are with Mr and Mrs Dubois.)
