

## B1.13.2 Le futur antérieur : formation

Le futur antérieur : formation



The future perfect is a compound tense used to express an action that will take place before a second action.

1. The future perfect is formed with the auxiliary "avoir" or "être" in the simple future + a past participle.
2. The auxiliary "avoir" is used for the majority of verbs.
3. The auxiliary "être" is used to indicate a change of place or state and for pronominal verbs.

Il/Elle/On sera arrivé(e) (He/She/One/We will have arrived)	Il/Elle/On aura fini (He/She/One/We will have finished)	Il/Elle/On aura pris (He/She/One/We will have taken)
Nous serons arrivé(e)s (We will have arrived)	Nous aurons fini (We will have finished)	Nous aurons pris (We will have taken)
