

A1.2.2 Polski alfabet

The Polish alphabet consists of 32 letters. It is based on the Latin alphabet and includes characters with diacritical marks: ą, ć, ę, Ł, ñ, ó, ś, ž, ż.

1. In the Polish language, digraphs (sz, rz, cz, dz, dż, dź) are used, which represent single sounds.
2. In addition to digraphs, the Polish alphabet also has one **trigraph**, which is: dzi.
